The Epistle for the 3rd Sunday after Trinity is from the Book of Revelations.

I saw seven angels who stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets. And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden thurible; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was brought before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand. All the angels stood around the throne and about the elders and the four beasts fell and worshipped God Saying; Amen; Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honour and power and might, be unto our God for ever and ever Amen.
