The 4th Sunday in Lent (Refreshment Sunday)

Intent - Spiritual Refreshment.

The Collect.

Almighty God, grant that we may prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries of the passion and resurrection, that we may be refreshed by the continual outpouring of your power from on high; through the Christ our Lord. Amen.

Be with us O Lord in all our doings and further us with thy continual help, that in all our works, begun, continued and ended in thee, we may glorify thy Holy Name through the Christ our Lord. Amen.
