Maundy Thursday

White.

Intent - The Lord's Supper

Candles Many.

Altar Cross veiled White.

Sufficient Host should be consecrated to supply reserved Sacrament for Good Friday and Holy Saturday.

The Collect.

O God who gives us the mystery of The Eucharist, grant us the ability to reverently receive the mystical powers sent to us via the Host, and to bathe in the spiritual upliftment that accompanies these powers, this we ask in the name of our Lord The Christ. Amen.

Be with us O Lord in all our doings and further us with thy continual help, that in all our works, begun, continued and ended in thee, we may glorify thy Holy Name through the Christ our Lord. Amen.

The Epistle for Maundy Thursday is from the 37th Psalm.

Put your trust in The Lord, and be doing good; delight in The Lord, and put all your trust in Him, and he will provide guidance. He shall clearly mark your road, and note all your deeds. O rest in The Lord, wait patiently for His summons, for the patient and good shall rise to greater glory, and reside in the mantle of peace.

The Gospel for Maundy Thursday is from the Book of John.

Jesus said "Amen Amen I say to you, he that believeth in me has everlasting life. I am the bread of life, and my Host is the bread with the life force which comes from the higher planes; if anyone accepts this they shall rise above carnal things to new understanding, and the bread given for the world is my flesh".
