## The Gospel for the 3rd Sunday after Easter is from the words of Sir Oliver Lodge.

Death is separation of soul and body. Death is not extinction, as life is continuous. The condition of the whole universe is unchanged by death, and life goes on under different surroundings. Those who have parted company with their physical body find that they have a body made of something else than the physical matter we are accustomed to here, but it is substantial, just as good as their old bodies, and indeed rather better. The teachings of Jesus and other great masters and philosophers are turned into truths for those who have experienced the touch of death; but it is better for everyone to grasp these truths while still living in the physical body. There can be no possible doubt about this, just as there is no room for doubt in the reality of a spiritual world. As the great Socrates said – THE SOUL IS IMMORTAL AND IMPERISHABLE AND WILL ALWAYS EXIST IN ANOTHER WORLD OF SPIRIT, AND THAT IS WITHOUT ANY DOUBT.
