Intent - Coming of the Holy Spirit.

Candles Many.

The Collect.

O Lord who art the fire of Pentecost, we beg you to continue to renew the face of the Earth by your infinite love and wisdom, and allow us to serve you now and evermore, God throughout the ages of ages. Amen.

The Epistle for the day called Pentecost is from the works of the teacher Rabu.

If the Holy Spirit passes your door and it is firmly closed, there is not the slightest chance that the Holy Spirit will impinge upon your free will and demand entry. It will pass on to try the next door, the next, and the next, until it finds a door which is not only open, but with the invitation to enter. Those who invite the Spirit to enter will be shown the road of contentment. This road leads to the unfolding of our consciousness in a manner that will far exceed our highest expectations or aspirations. There is no calendar marking the date when the Holy Spirit may see fit to approach us. We must ever keep an open invitation within our hearts. The Holy Spirit has and will always see each and every invitation, so have no fear that you will go un–noticed. The Holy Spirit has never ever refused a genuine invitation to enter into any heart.

The Gospel for Pentecost is from the words of the Cyclopean Master, Lord Aramu-Meru.

Lord Aramu-Meru said: --- This is an open invitation for all those who would align themselves with right, good, truth, light and peace. Upon the horizon Armageddon is shortly to come to pass. The forces of darkness are aligning themselves for the final death throes of darkness upon earth. We can hear the marching feet, for they are now marching upon the etheric planes, shortly to find physical manifestation upon earth. But yet this is a test of faith for us.
