The Gospel for the 7th Sunday after Trinity is from the words of Bishop Herman Spruit.

The Soul's highest act is worship. It is the act that brings the greatest degree of consciousness of the Blessings of God. You cannot know God's fullness in any other way but the way of worship. It makes the great change within you. It brings forth the divine image into all departments and compartments of your life. You cannot worship God without becoming like him. If we worship a God without becoming like him, it is because we worship an unknown God. Not knowing him, we cannot become like him; but even not knowing him, he will give you the full chance to learn to know him. This is through worship which is the motion of love.
