Intent - The Living Spark Within

O boundless God we pray thee to fire the spark of thy self within us, and give us the spiritual boost that only you can impart to us, this we ask in the name of The Christ Power. Amen

O Universal Creator, grant to us the wisdom to recognise the Avatar you send to us, and with this recognition we may cease our searching for the pathway to you; knowing our feet are pointing in your direction and guided by your love, this we ask in the name of your Christed Messenger. Amen.

We know that the God of this universe is our true source of our life, health, happiness, peace and prosperity. God is love, and each of us drawn here today by the law of attraction, chooses to express that love in our lives moment by moment, day by day. The Gospel for the 2nd Sunday in Advent is from the Gospel of Emerson.

What we commonly call mankind, the eating, drinking, planting, counting person, does not as we know give a fair representation, but entirely misrepresents. This image we do not respect, but the soul whose organ the body is would make our knees bend if we only let it be seen. When soul breathes through intellect, it is genius; when it breathes through will, it is virtue; when it flows through affection, it is love.
