Hand signs for Blessing.

As one is ordained to each level, there is a certain position for the hands and fingers of their rank when they bless anything. This is most important as this energises the appropriate energy that the person is ordained to carry. For instance, when a person is ordained to Cleric, the Crown centre is the one that vibrates to their energy giving the maximum energy they are capable of. As the person rises in rank, a different centre comes into play to vibrate with the energy they are capable of dispensing. One must know which is right for their level of rank and use the appropriate hand sign during blessings to gain the best results from any blessing they do. This does not run in a logical sequence, but runs in this order of centres for the various rising levels.

Hand Signs:

Cleric	Crown	thumb holding down the first finger, other three extended
Doorkeeper	Third Eye	thumb holding down the second finger, all others extended
Reader	Heart	thumb holding down the little finger all others extended
Healer/Exorcist	Solar Plexus	hand presented flat thumb to palm, all others extended
Acolyte	Genital	thumb holding down first and second fingers, others extended
Sub Deacon	Base	thumb holding down the first and little fingers, others extended
Deacon	Throat	thumb holding down the ring finger, others extended
Priest	Navel	thumb holding down ring and little finger, others extended
Bishop	Aura	thumb holding down second and ring finger, others extended like
		a pair of horns

It will be noted that in most other churches the priests use the healer exorcist sign, and the bishops use the priest's sign. This is a throwback to the times when many bishops were practical black magic practitioners, and the church tried to use different signs to show they were not in the black arts. The correct signs however are as above and used in our church.
